Requirements for Admission Contract Associated Student Body/Leadership Coronado High School

Membership in the Associated Student Body/Leadership class is a privilege and there are high expectations in terms of work ethic, character, leadership and service. If you are interested in running for an officer or appointee position within this class, please complete the form below.

Work ethic: Students are expected to attend all ASB sponsored activities, on and off campus, during and after school hours, during the school year, breaks and summer vacation. They are expected to help plan, execute, and promote these activities. Students who do not manage their time effectively, do not complete projects by their deadlines, or choose to use this class as a social hour, study hall, or otherwise do not demonstrate a strong work ethic, may be asked to step down from their position and/or will earn a grade that represents their level of effort.

Character: Their peers, school staff, and the community view members of the Associated Student Body/Leadership class as leaders on and off campus. Student leaders should demonstrate good character and integrity in all facets of their life, including but not limited to academics, athletics, extra-curricular activities, employment and social activities. Leadership students should not violate school rules, including dress code, lunch policy, etc. Excessive absences or tardies in ANY class may result in restriction of ASB activities and responsibilities and may be reflected in your grade. Leadership is a responsibility and those students not upholding the standards of Islander character may be asked to step down from their position and/or face other consequences.

Leadership: Students are expected to lead their peers within the ASB/Leadership class and on and off campus. Students should be able to delegate, accept feedback, give feedback, perform the tasks assigned to them, self-reflect, and represent the Islander student body. Being a member of ASB does not place you above other students or give you rights not granted to others. You must treat all authority figures with respect, regardless of the situation. Again, leadership is a responsibility and those students not upholding the standards of Islander character or expectations for leadership may be asked to step down from their position, face other consequences, and/or earn a grade representative of their leadership skills and effort.

Service: Service to self, school and community are expected within ASB/Leadership. Students should willingly and happily volunteer their time, whether asked or not, in ASB, the school in general, and the community. Giving back is an important trait that all good leaders possess – giving back your time, your energy, your spirit, your effort. Students will be required to meet ASB service hour requirements. Students who fail to contribute to ASB, CHS, or the community may be asked to step down from their position, face other consequences, and/or earn a grade representative of their leadership skills and effort.
